WSWA STANDS IN STRONG OPPOSITION OF USTR PROPOSED EXPANSION OF RETALIATORY TARIFFS ON EU WINE AND SPIRITS

WASHINGTON, D.C., 06/24/2020 – Following months of tariffs on imported EU wine and spirits, the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) yesterday announced <u>a proposal</u> for additional tariffs on EU spirits, liqueurs and cordials from all EU members not currently facing tariffs in retaliation of the ongoing World Trade Organization (WTO) Airbus/Boeing dispute. Wine & Spirits Wholesalers of America (WSWA) President and CEO Michelle Korsmo released the following statement:

"America's family-owned wine and spirits wholesalers stand united with industry partners in opposition to the U.S. tariffs on EU alcohol products and the EU's tariff on American Whiskey and urge the Administration and our EU trading partners to end this unnecessary trade dispute. The USTR implemented these tariff levels in a healthy global economy – today, we ask the USTR take the current state of affairs into consideration and resolve these issues before greater harm is inflicted on the industry."
